WILDWOOD FILM FESTIVAL REQUIREMENTS

The Wildwood Film Festival is a non-profit event designed to showcase emerging independent films/filmmakers from Wisconsin. The primary creative personnel, such as director, producer, screenwriter, should have Wisconsin ties. This would include such examples as a Wisconsin native, resident for 1 or more years, or alumnus of a Wisconsin university. Consideration will be given to films with lead actors or actresses from Wisconsin or primary footage shot in Wisconsin.

Early deadline: Postmarked by November 1, 2007

Submission fee: \$10 per work, \$5 for student

Final regular deadline: Postmarked by December 31, 2007

Submission fee: \$20 per work, \$10 for student

For discounted fees as well as an extended deadline visit www.withoutabox.com. This is our PREFERRED way to receive your submission. Eventually this will be the ONLY method.

Festival date: April 12, 2008

Location: Fox Cities Performing Arts Center (Downtown Appleton)

- Types of Films accepted: Primary focus is on humor. All genres are considered.
- **ATTENTION:** New this season!! Time limit is 60 minutes
- The festival will not consider commercials or advertisements; industrial films such as medical, educational or informational.
- Previous commercial release for theater, TV, cable, or video distribution will not be accepted.
- Entries submitted should be completed projects since 1-01-05. No works in progress will be considered.
- Entrants may submit more than one film. Each entry will require a separate entry form and submission fee. Multiple submissions can be mailed together.
- Formats for submission are limited to DVD. Exhibition format is limited DVD.
- Entrants are legally responsible for securing all necessary rights/permission for talent, music, or product trademarks contained in submitted works.

- Entries will be reviewed by a minimum of 3 staff members. The content of the festival is based on a vote by the staff. All decisions are final.

ENRTRIES MUST INCLUDE:

1. 2 DVD copies of each film. ATTENTION!
2. Entry fee for each film. (Payable to Wildwood Productions Inc.)
3. Completed and signed entry form for each film.
4. List of primary cast and crewmembers.
5. Brief filmmaker bios.
6. Press kit if available.
7. Film synopsis. (under 75 words)

We will send confirmation of each work received. This will NOT serve as a confirmation of acceptance or denial.

Submitted work will not be returned.

If entry is accepted, filmmakers will be contacted. Additional details regarding the event will be provided at that time.

If accepted, Wildwood Film Festival staff will request, (but not require), a photo or digital file of the director or a still image from film for publicity purposes.
